

E12 Scholarship Package Information

E12 eases the financial pressure of studying through a first-year scholarship and gives you plenty of support throughout your first year.

ACCESS Membership

E12 provides you with free 2019 [ACCESS membership](#) to the [University of Sydney Union \(USU\)](#). Your ACCESS membership allows you to join clubs and societies, receive discounts on food, drink and retail across campus, and participate in many USU programs and events including festivals, events, volunteering, and professional development. Visit any of the USU Info Hubs with a form of photo ID to activate your account and receive your ACCESS details – benefits are redeemed digitally, by logging into the USU app and using the barcode on your digital membership.

The USU Info Hubs are located on Level 1, Manning House, Level 4, Wentworth Building and on the Front Lawns during Welcome Week. Your membership can be claimed at any point after Wednesday 20 February 2019. Visit usu.edu.au/contact-us.aspx for opening hours of the Info Hubs and more information about the USU.

Scholarship Funds

If you remain enrolled in your E12 course in a full time capacity during your first year of study, you will receive the scholarship funds in two payments:

- \$2,975 after census date (31/3) in Semester 1
- \$2,975 after census date (31/8) in Semester 2

To ensure you receive your funds after these deadlines, you will need to provide the full details of the **bank account** you want funds deposited.

Please enter these details in the MyFinance tab in the [Sydney Student](#) portal, accessed via MyUni.

Note: To be eligible for this scholarship, you must fulfil all application criteria and application deadlines and be made an unconditional offer from UAC for an undergraduate place through the E12 scheme. **You must accept your E12 offer & remain enrolled (full time) in that course throughout your first year to receive the full scholarship package.**

Academic Skills Workshop

Apply for a place at a residential college without paying the application fee and be supported during your first year with full board, pastoral care, academic assistance and a ready made college community.
