



Country Education Foundation of Australia Student Impact Report



Harry's CEF support started in 2019 when he relocated 380km away from home to study at the University of New South Wales, graduating in 2022 with a Bachelor of Advanced Science, achieving First Class Honours in Microbiology.

Taya grew up in Coolah, population 1,200, and is in her final year of a Certificate III in Carpentry and Joinery at TAFE Mudgee. Thanks to local grants from CEF Coolah, she has been able to pay for her travel to TAFE - a 200km round trip on regional roads - and purchase necessary tools needed for her course.

In 2025, Taya is looking to move to Mudgee to be closer to TAFE and achieve her goals of undertaking an apprenticeship within the local Mudgee community.

The continued support from CEF over my whole higher education journey has been extremely helpful. I am very grateful to be able to receive this support as it really has made it possible for me to move away and continue to study. Beyond the funding received, the community fostered in the broader CEF has helped me to make some really great connections and I look forward to continuing this.
